

## Nashville Weekend Trip Plans

Upon your arrival in Nashville you will have some time to explore this beautiful town prior to meeting at 'Out of the Ordinary' at 5:30 pm for dinner. We will distribute the tickets for the Playhouse at dinner. We will go to the Playhouse approximately 7:00 pm (Across the street).

Included are the following maps:

- \* Map of your meeting place, 'Wheels of Wonder', 175 Southern Plaza Drive. From there Tammy and Butch will lead you to Nashville.
- \* Map of downtown Nashville with Arranged Parking, Cornerstone Inn, Out of the Ordinary and The Playhouse marked with a red asterisk.
- \* Map of the Cornerstone Inn grounds and an information sheet regarding the Inn.

When you arrive in Nashville, you will be heading south on Van Buren St. Turn left on Franklin Street after you pass 'Out of the Ordinary' on your left. For those not spending the night, go one block and turn left on Old School Way. The parking lot is behind the restaurant. The parking will be on your right, just past Cornerstone Inn. For those spending the night, Cornerstone Inn is on the corner of Franklin and Old School Way. You will need to continue on Franklin and turn left just past the hotel into the parking lot, where you will be able to park while checking in. Once you have checked in, you will be able to move your car to a permanent parking place. Yes they are aware we have Corvettes.

We understand there are a few cars that will not be in the caravan, due to early arrival or later arrival. Please reply and let us know your plans. This will allow Tammy and Butch to know how many cars to expect for the caravan.

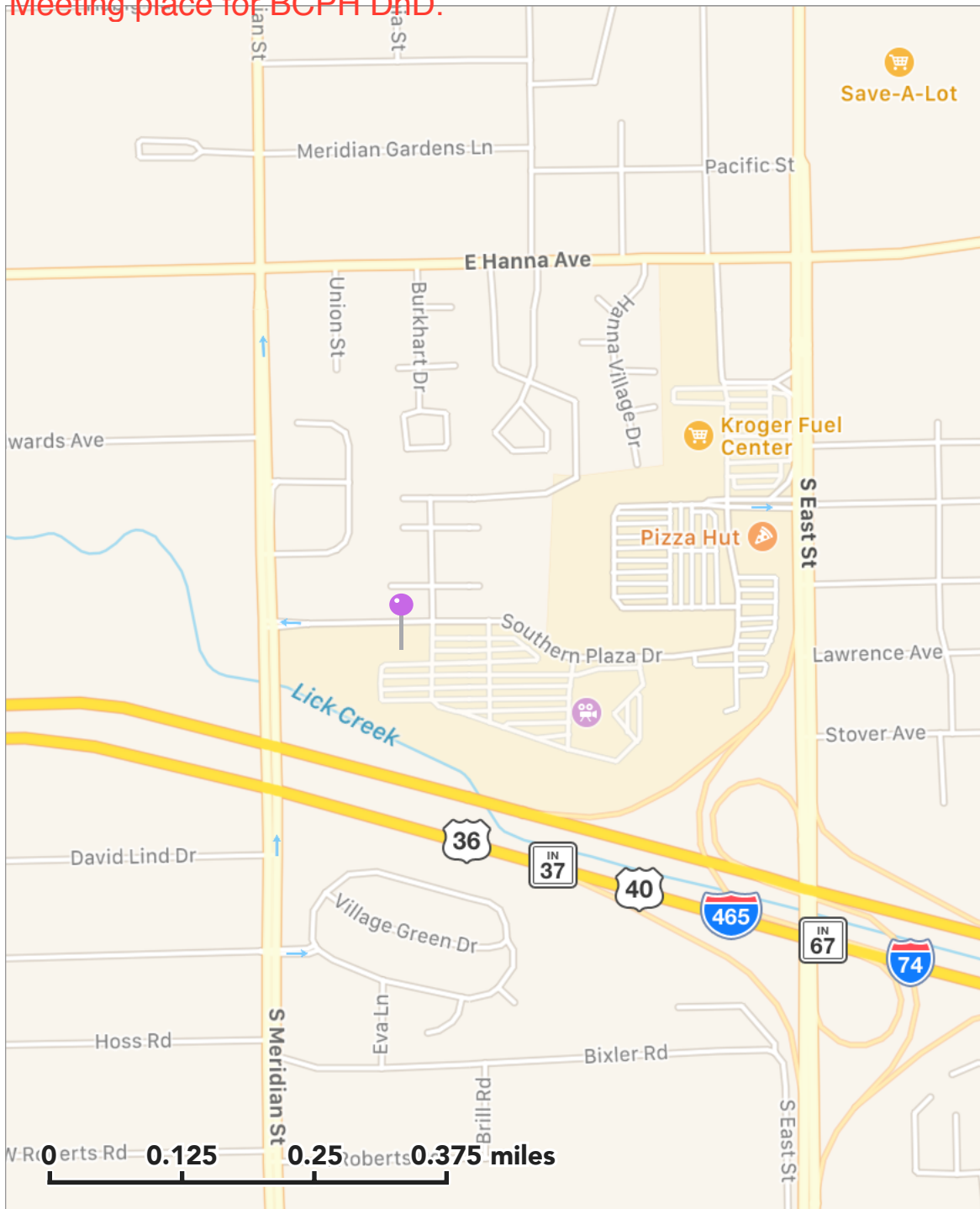

A \$150.00 charge will be assessed for breach of above policy.

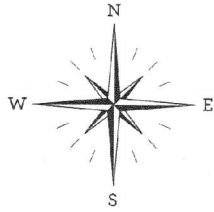


